Annual Report 2016-17

- The Department of Mathematics celebrated commemoration of Prof. K.N.G. Unnithan on November 7th, 2016. Principal Dr. K. Mohankumar inaugurated the function. A talk was delivered by Prof. M.Somasekharan Pillai, HoD, Statistics, University College, Thiruvananthapuram. Students who secured first in University exams of UG and PG, and students of Statistics Department who secured first in subsidiary Mathematics were awarded.

- The Department of Mathematics conducted a three days National Seminar on " Analysis and Applications" from 18-20 February 2016. The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. G. Suresh Singh, Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics, University of Kerala.

- The Department of Sanskrit has conducted a Lecture in connection with Ramayanamasacharana and Sanskrit day celebration on 11.08.2016. Dr. D Latheesh, Principal D.B.College, Sasthamcotta inaugurated this seminar and the programme was presided over by Dr. M.S Maya, HOD, Sanskrit Department. Dr. N. Viswarajan, Former HOD, S.N. Dr.K.Santhosh, Associate Prof, Dept.of Sanskrit extended vote of thanks. In the afternoon session, Kalamandalam Rajeev and Kalamandalam Prasanth have led a demonstration class on “*mudras* in Kathakali” with fascinated students as audience. - The Department of English has been subscribing the newspaper *Deccan Chronicle* to Sasthamcotta Gramodharana Grandhashala, the village library and this has been beneficial to many educated people who do not normally have access to this prestigious daily.
- The students of PG classes conducted peer-teaching to the students of UG classes.
- The Department has been conducting online extra classes for PG students to enable them to fare well in their Comprehensive Examination Paper,

which will also enable them to qualify UGC National Eligibility Test. Many students have benefitted from this coaching.

- The Department of English organized the Annual Endowment Distribution on September 9.
- An one day workshop on Experimental Physics (WEP) for higher secondary students was conducted on 30/06/2016 from 9 am to 4pm. The workshop was organised with a vision to provide a platform for Plus Two students to discuss and perform various experiments in our laboratory under the guidance of the teachers of this department. ACTIVITIES 2016-2017

Environment Day Programmes
