The resource persons conducted periodical tests and assignments and given back to the students after correction. They assessed the progress of the students accordingly. All the resource persons the two page activity report and faculty diary in the prescribed format on completion of the sessions. The study materials suggested by the faculty members along with those prepared by the Department of Higher Education to the students. A list of suggested text books were handed over to the coordinator from certain departments which were procured through outside book stalls. The amount remained after all these were evaluated and utilised completely for the purchase of text books as study materials. **Text books worth sum of Rs.39,631.00 ( Rupees thirty nine six hundred and thirty one Only) were procured under this scheme and included in the Stock.**

### **ANALYSIS OF FEED BACK OF FACULTY MEMBERS**

The feed back were collected from the resource persons of the SSP 16-17 in the prescribed format. The important suggestions include the allotment of more

sessions for the paper as the students selected were slow learners and weak, implementation of more external mentoring sessions on each semester by experts to improve the level of confidence and positive attitude in these children. In certain disciplines where there were no text books available, the study materials were also prepared as bound volume and included in the stock as study materials.

## **EXTERNAL MENTORING CLASSES**

The external mentoring sessions were engaged by **Ms. Maya Susan Jacob, Consulting Psychologist, Girideepam group of Institutions, Kottayam** on **18<sup>th</sup> February, 2017**. **Three sessions of one hour duration each were handled on topics** . The teachers were allowed only for one session after which there sessions were completely dedicated for the selected students of SSP. The general feed back about the sessions showed that the students were impressed. They expressed their heart felt feeling that sessions like this should be extended to their parents. Then only it will be completely beneficial. The students were motivated well and they were freely and actively interacting with the resource person. A two hour mentoring session was handled by **Dr. R. Sushil Kumar, Associate Professor, Department of English, D. B. College, Sasthamcotta**. **He concentrated on Effective communication and Career Perspectives to the students. It was on 04<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.**

The CLMC members convened their meetings periodically to review and assess the status of the programme. There were six meetings summoned in the last semester in connection with the evaluation of the progress of the same. Being the coordinator, I am submitting this report for the kind consideration, perusal and
